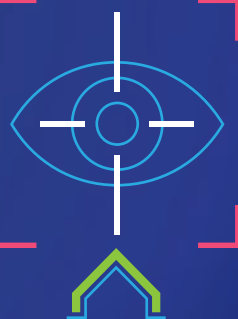

## A Man on the Street

My first assignment as an Agent of Change was self-imposed in 1997. At the time, I was a student at Temple University studying for an academic career in Anthropology with a focus on urban environments. I commuted by bicycle from school to a café where I worked in Center City, Philadelphia.

Riding side streets to avoid traffic, I discovered pockets of unhoused people in parks and under bridges. The more routes I took, the more people I saw sleeping outside.

These experiences convinced me that my best self was served not in the classroom, but through direct engagement with people on the street. My mission for three decades has focused on outreach, staffing emergency shelters, and responding to housing crises on city streets.

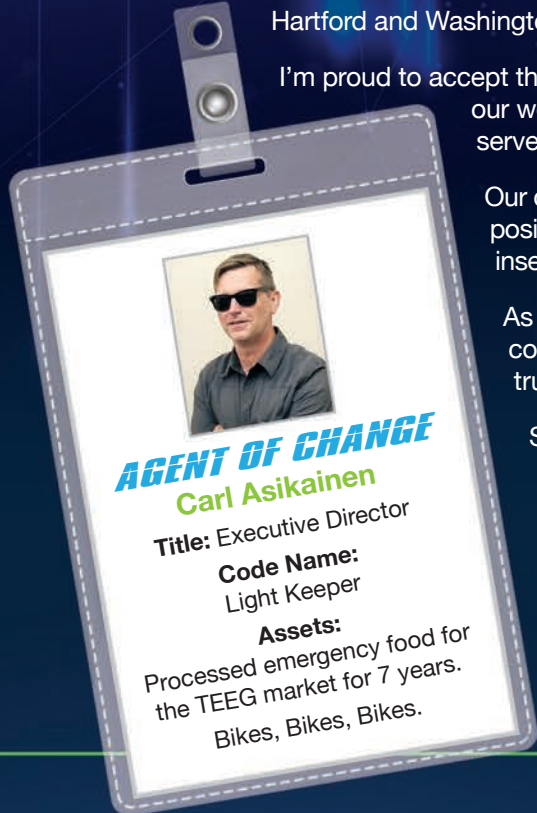
I've also had the opportunity to do farmer-based outreach for gleaning programs, conduct SNAP and feeding program education, lead the charge statewide in Connecticut to document youth homelessness and advocate for food and housing support with our representatives in Hartford and Washington.

I'm proud to accept the assignment to be TEEG's Executive Director. A large part of our work as Agents of Change is not just for the communities we serve but also for those who want to participate with us in any way.

Our donors, volunteers, and supporters look to us to help bring positive change to marginalized youth, to those struggling with food insecurity, to help new parents, and to provide support to seniors.

As a vehicle for direct engagement, TEEG works to create the conditions for positive change to take place. Thank you for trusting us to do this important local work.

In 2021, a study commissioned by Dalio Education showed that one in five Connecticut youth are disconnected or at risk of disconnection\*. According to the report, there is an alarming concentration of those youth in the state's northeast corner.

Our Youth Advocates, mentors, and Juvenile Review Board are Agents dedicated to changing this reality. They spend time working alongside youth and their families with wraparound services to identify pathways to community connection.

Their selfless commitment to inspiring a change in direction is a force that we believe will help to make a difference in the future of these young people and their ability to find their place in our community.

*\* NOTE: The Dalio report's definition of disconnection is based on whether an individual (age 14 to 16) is connected to employment and/or educational attainment.*

# TEEG PROGRAM PROFILES ∞ PART 1



## Food Delivery



Our work in rural Connecticut has long included a strong connection to local home-bound seniors.

Because we never stop trying to better help neighbors in need, monthly deliveries set up during the pandemic have become a permanent offering.

Here's how it works... Seniors receive a call before their delivery to choose from items currently available in our markets that best meet their dietary needs and preferences. Volunteers then package and deliver their orders with warmth and compassion. Conversations lead to other ways to provide help, from fuel assistance to transportation information.

Our winter Sassy Soup Sisters deliveries further strengthen these connections and expand our ability to check in with nourishing interactions during months that often are times of isolation.

## SMART Recovery



Local Change Agent Romeo Blackmer approached us in the spring of 2021 with a new program idea – SMART Recovery.

The objective is to provide support, skills, and training for people suffering from the effects of substance use and addiction, and offer support to their loved ones through SMART Recovery Family and Friends.

Led by volunteer facilitators, the group brings needed support to our area. This year, we have added a SMART Recovery Youth program for adolescents ages 15-19.

Why volunteer to help others? Because doing good feels good and it fosters change.

Some jobs require inter-agency partnerships to achieve our mission.

In 2022, we teamed up with the Connecticut Humane Society and the Eastern Connecticut Foundation to launch Operation Healthy Companions, a true example of connecting the dots to bring needed services to our area.

Pet food clinics help people feed their four-legged friends, veterinary clinics help keep them well, and supply pet owners with flea and tick prevention to help pets stay that way.

We also equip area first responders and service providers with instructions about safe pet practices. These Change Agents are kind, caring, and speak the language of animal lovers everywhere!

## Case Management



Advocacy is perhaps the most direct route to positive change. TEEG Case Managers have the grit, determination, and keen investigative know-how to fill this vital role. Working behind the scenes, they navigate ever-changing requirements and red tape that service providers request with the adept skill of keyboard commandos. They are also experts in gathering human intelligence (HUMINT) to find the best solution for each case, from a heating issue solution to a homelessness response.

## Strong Like a Mother



Transformation happens in so many ways. Sometimes, it is out in the open, and sometimes, it's quietly guided by a caring support system offering a warm welcome and encouragement. TEEG's postpartum support group is just that. Change Agents who support members are made possible by a funding angel who believes that giving babies and new moms the best chance for a strong start in life is important. Strong Like a Mother is run by Erin Drake, who is trained to guide parents through sleep issues, self-care, and routine. Connections are made in the safe space of online Zoom meetings, serving families from all over our region and beyond.





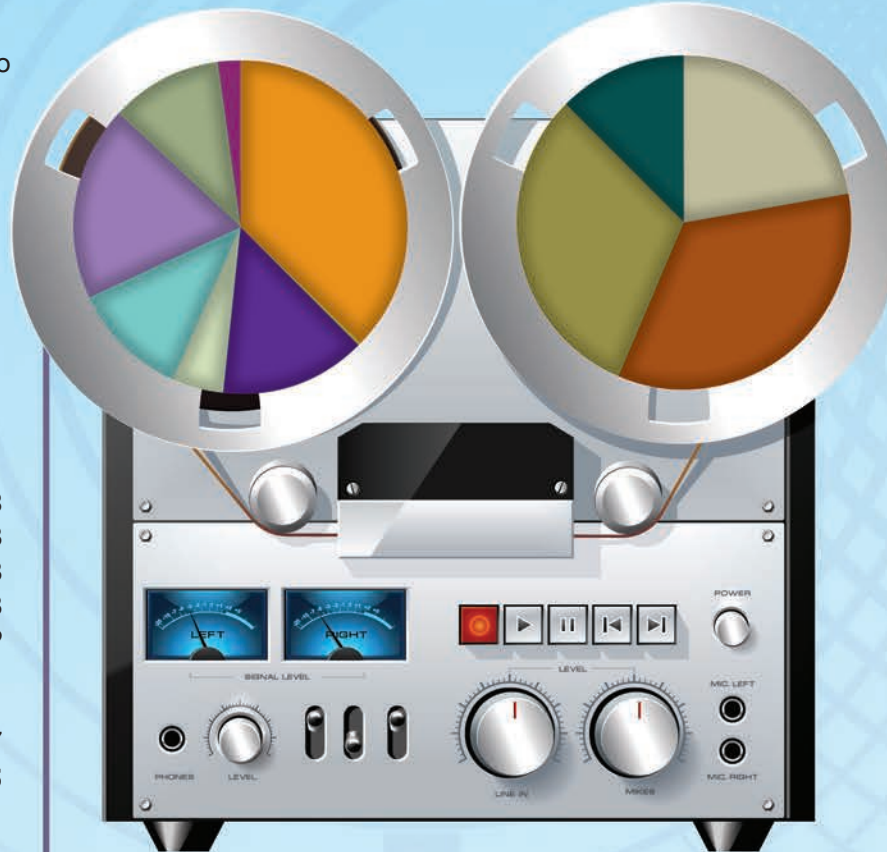
